AWARDS CEREMONY DRESS CODE

A Dress Code will be enforced during the Awards Ceremony. To accept an award "on-stage", the student must wear the "Official SkillsUSA Uniform", State T-Shirt or the competition attire. NO SHORTS OR HATS!!!

EACH COMPETITORS MUST PROVIDE A 1 PAGE RESUME' AT THE BEGINNING OF THE CONTEST, THERE IS A 10 PT. DEDUCTION IF ONE IS NOT TURNED IN AT THIS TIME.

TASKS TO BE PERFORMED:

The contest will consist of written exam (taken online March 14-28, 2025), basic and advanced Router and Switch configurations and troubleshooting network connectivity. The router and switch portion will be delivered in a virtualized environment using Cisco Packet Tracer version 7.

Hands-On Evaluation:

The purpose of the hands-on component of the contest will be to test a contestant's ability to design, install, troubleshoot, and maintain internetworks. Given a set of networking equipment (cable, fiber, hubs/switches, routers, etc.), the contestants must, in a finite amount of time, install or repair a network and demonstrate that the installation properly runs internet applications. Given a logical topology and network requirements, the contestants will be able to develop a useable network that meets or exceeds the documentation provided.

STUDENT MUST SUPPLY (Contestants will not be allowed to share laptop/tools):

- 1-page resume
- Pencil or pen
